Welcome to the Flagler Beach Historical Museum! We are located in the heart of the historic seaside community of Flagler Beach, one block west of the fishing pier.

Our established collections range from pre-historic, Native American and colonial plantation artifacts to images and items from our town's roaring 1920s and World War II encounters with German submarines.

Our new Recent History displays feature local surfing legends, severe weather events, and critters and creatures that have paid us a visit. Come walk in the footsteps of mastodons and mammoths, shipwrecked French sailors, Charles Lindbergh, and the founding families of "Ocean City."

Points of Interest

The idea of the Flagler Beach Historical Museum was born while planning the 75th Celebration for the City in April 2000. Pictures were gathered from various pioneer family members and shared with people interested in the history of Flagler Beach. The pictures begin as the earliest recorded history and follow the growth and progress of the little town known as Ocean City from 1913 to 1923.

The town of Flagler Beach was incorporated in 1925 and enjoyed growth and prosperity until the Great Depression. The depression years of the 1930s were difficult and followed by the hardships of the early 1940s and World War II. But at the war's end, and through the 1960s, Flagler Beach was a quiet fishing village.

Records on display include those from the old fire department, the City Judge's casebook, voter registration rolls, and many newspaper articles documenting the major happenings through the years. Artifacts include original Coast Guard passes that were required to cross the bridge at night during the war, a silver salad fork inscribed "Flagler Beach Hotel", and a 1940s Deputy Sheriff badge.
